

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED 2020-B PLAN FOR THE ALLOCATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF REGIONAL GREENHOUSE GAS INITIATIVE AUCTION PROCEEDS

The Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources (OER) proposes the <u>2020-B Plan for the Allocation and</u> <u>Distribution of Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Auction Proceeds</u> (2020-B Plan) and gives notice of intent to hold a public hearing to receive public comment on the proposed Plan and to afford interested parties an opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments orally and/or in writing on the proposed 2020-B Plan.
