



Electric Vehicle Charging Stations Lead by Example Program – RI Office of Energy Resources

The Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources (OER), through its Lead by Example (LBE) Initiative, has been working with state agencies for a number of years, developing and implementing clean energy projects. The Electric Vehicle Charging Station Program’s goal is to make it easier for all RI state agencies to transition towards electric vehicles, and we understand that access to charging infrastructure is crucial for this transition. Therefore, we will do everything in our power to secure funding and ensure that charging stations are available for everyone who needs them.

The Lead By Example Initiative does not guarantee funding for the installation of charging stations and any funding made by OER is at its full discretion. However, we are committed to working towards identifying any available funding sources, including grants, to support the installation of these stations.

Eligibility

All Rhode Island State Agencies are eligible to apply and participate in this program, subject to availability of funds.

Application Process

- An eligible entity must submit a completed program application.
- Each application will be reviewed for eligibility and other criteria by OER staff. OER reserves the right to request additional information directly from the applicant prior to making its final award determination. Submission of an application alone does not guarantee funding.
- If approved, OER will notify the applicant electronically or in writing.
- Once approved, OER will schedule with the listed contact person a site visit. This site visit will help generate a scope of work.
- OER will provide the agency with a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that will describe the financial commitment and terms of cooperation between the parties.
- Any financial awards offered through this program are made on a first-come, first-served basis and are contingent on the availability of funds. OER – at its sole discretion – reserves the right to accept, reject, or request modifications to any application for reasons including, but not limited to, availability of funding and/or failure to meet all eligibility and other program criteria.
