

# RI National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Program (NEVI)

The RI Office of Energy Resources (OER) is the lead agency administering the NEVI RI EV Infrastructure Plan in partnership with the RI Department of Transportation (RIDOT) and the RI Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM).

## What is NEVI

Signed by President Joe Biden in November 2021, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) establishes the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Formula Program (“NEVI Formula”) to provide funding to States to strategically deploy electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure and to establish an interconnected network to facilitate data collection, access, and reliability.

## NEVI Phase 1 & 2



### Phase 1

Phase 1 of the NEVI program launched in December 2023 with a focus on the installation of electric vehicle DC Fast Chargers (Level 3) charging stations located at the Ashaway Park & Ride and Route 117 Park & Ride in Warwick. Construction at the Ashaway Park & Ride location began in February 2024.



### Phase 2

After Phase 1 is complete, the state can use NEVI Program funds for EV charging infrastructure on any public road or other publicly accessible location.

As part of the planning process, we want to gather insights from the general public and business entities. Your feedback on EV charging stations and EV’s is crucial to shaping the success of Phase 2 of the NEVI program.

## Phase 2 Survey
