### NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING

#### ***PROPOSED 2024-A PLAN FOR THE ALLOCATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF REGIONAL GREENHOUSE GAS INITIATIVE AUCTION PROCEEDS***

The Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources (OER) proposes the 2024-A Plan for the Allocation and Distribution of Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Auction Proceeds (2024-A Plan) and gives notice of intent to hold a public hearing to receive public comment on the Proposed Plan and to afford interested parties an opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments orally and/or in writing.

The proposed 2024-A Plan allocates and distributes Rhode Island's Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Program proceeds from the first two auctions held in 2023. The public hearing will be held on **May 17, 2024, at 2:00 p.m.** in Conference Room 2A, Second Floor of the Powers Building, One Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island. The place of the public hearing is accessible to individuals who have a disability. OER encourages the submission of written comments. The public record will be kept open for ten (10) calendar days following the conclusion of the public hearing to allow additional time for the submission of written comments.
