Administered by the Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources (OER) in partnership with the community action agencies or CAPs, the HEAR program is providing low-income Rhode Islanders with rebates to upgrade electrical wiring, install new electrical panels and replace existing gas stoves and clothes dryers with efficient electric alternatives. The moderateincome pathway will launch next year. OER is recruiting electricians to complete wiring, panel, and appliance upgrades and pipefitters to cap gas lines.




