### NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING

#### PROPOSED 2014 PLAN FOR THE ALLOCATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF REGIONAL GREENHOUSE GAS INITIATIVE AUCTION PROCEEDS

The Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources proposes the “2014 Plan for The Allocation and Distribution of Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Auction Proceeds” and gives notice of intent to hold a public hearing to receive public comment on the proposed Plan and to afford interested parties an opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments orally and/or in writing on the proposed Plan.


The public hearing will be held on **July 2, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.** in Conference Room A, Second Floor of the Powers Building, One Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island. The hearing room is accessible to the handicapped. A stenographic record of the hearing will be made. The Department of Administration will provide interpreter services for the hearing impaired, provided such a request is made at least three (3) business days prior to the hearing date. Requests for such services may be made in writing or by calling TTY (711) or (401) 222-5300.

The proposed 2014 Allocation Plan allocates and distributes 2013 auction proceeds from the Rhode Island Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Program.
